Mission

To organize healthcare stakeholders by providing a structured forum for sharing valuable knowledge, finding common solutions, and identifying resources to improve health outcomes, improve quality and patient experience of care, and to lower costs of care in Clearwater, Idaho, Latah, Lewis and Nez Perce Counties.

GOALS

Convene and organize regional healthcare stakeholders to:

1. Support practices as they transform to PCMHs, and support existing PCMHs expansion and enhancement; promote future participation in the SHIP.
2. Link PCMHs to the broader Medical/Health Neighborhood to facilitate coordinated patient care and create alignment across primary and specialty care delivery
3. Support population health initiatives
4. Communicate regional efforts, successes, and challenges across all other Regional Collaboratives, PCMH practices, and the IHC.
5. Develop a sustainability plan for the RC2 with input from all partners.

RC2 Involvement

OBJECTIVES:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Encourage practices to participate in the PCMH Model Test Program Provide coordination and integration solutions to PCMHs Identify opportunities for shared resources and provide targeted assistance for under-resourced clinics Develop a standard method/platform for PCMH practices to communicate successes, challenges, improvement strategies, etc.

Goal 2: Medical Health Neighborhood Development and Linkage
OBJECTIVES:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Define Medical Health Neighborhood (MHN) for our region Identify unmet health, behavioral health, wellness, and social needs Build and support relationships with community partners and resources

Goal 3: Support Population Health Initiatives
OBJECTIVES:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Review community health needs assessments (CHNA), regional data from data analytics contractor, the <i>Get Healthy Idaho</i> report, and other reliable data sources and create recommendations. Identify unmet health, behavioral health, wellness, and social needs using CHNA, PCMH feedback, and other reliable sources of information

Goal 4: Communication Plan
OBJECTIVES:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provide regular status updates to all the RC's and IHC detailing best-practices, challenges and successes in transformation of PCMH and integration of medical health neighborhoods Receive status reports (or observations of QI staff) from clinics and PCMH contractors with actionable support areas identified; provide assistance in these support areas, with emphasis on aid for under-resourced clinics. Receive requests for input from the IHC, and will research and provide recommendations to the IHC in various subject areas relative to the regional implementation of the SHIP

Goal 5: Sustainability
OBJECTIVES:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Identify stakeholders from the PCMHs and Medical Health Neighborhoods to convene the RC2 Evaluate membership regularly to maintain appropriate representation Establish community partners that support the RC2 mission Seek recommendations from members, the IHC, and other regional collaborative teams in development of the regional sustainability plan. Communicate and support the Regional Collaborative mission through community outreach activities Engage and emphasize meaningful work for RC2 members
